Period of project: October to December, 2020

Project description and progress: This project is successfully implemented with involving all the parties who got benefits (KMS school, children and their families), in local mission, KMMS school administration and BCSS Team. We have tried to get the contact with almost all the children in our program in boarding and village schools. They are the big beneficiaries from this project. Boarding school children and parents are scattered all around the country. We tried to reach them in their crisis time via mobile phone and distributed food package to them as per project design. Parents are grateful to donors for providing the food package. You will have look in the picture from children and project activities.

Did you encounter particular problems with the project? We do not have any major problem during the implementation. We have some hard time to reach the children via mobile communication, mainly very rural village even we could not reach some of them.

Who will benefit from the project and how will the local community benefit? Direct beneficiaries are the KMS school, children and their parents. This food package is big benefit during their crisis time. Parents do not have work during corona pandemic and passing hard time.

KMMS school community are getting benefit in the crisis. They have received rice for their cafeteria and fish seedlings for their income generating purpose, because of the flood they are affected largely. Their crops destroyed by the flood. 
