Final Special Project Report

Name of project: Toilet Project

Location: Bangladesh, BCSS is working with Four Missions (SBM-4, WBM-4, NBM-4 and EBM-5),

Period of project: 5 months (January to May 2018)

Project description and progress:

The seventeen (17) hygiene toilets have improved and renovated for betterment of our children and teachers. This project has implemented in SBM-4 toilets, WBM-4 toilets, NBM-4 toilets and EBM-5 toilets in successfully. The Project goal was 'To improve the minimum standard facilities on Hygiene Toilets in Seventeen (17) village schools of four missions'. 510 children and school teachers are benefited from this project. Sven (7) Toilets have developed/made newly and Ten (10) toilets renovated out of 17 toilets. As a result of toilet project implemention, as follows

- 1) 17 Toilets Improvement/Development
- 2) 510 Children and Schools Teachers are accessing the hygiene toilet.
- 3) It helped their good health and reduced many common diseases.
- 4) Children have started to use toilet in hill/Jungle areas.
- 5) Moreover Children and Teacher are enjoying the improving 17 toilets.

Leaders, Teacher, Children and Community people were involved in toilet project implementation. Even they gave their physical labour for successful task.

Children and Schools teachers are thankful to DCF Donor for this great effort and funding such as essential project here in Bangladesh. This project has brought positive changes in schools as well as children lives.

Did you encounter particular problems with the project?

The toilet project was going on fine. However there were some challenges during the project implementing in field level-Specially in EBM-hill area. It was so hard to carry the material from down to top of hill. These area roads are terrible and not fit for riding vehicle, people can walk only. And leaders were busy for several tasks beginning of the year. Finally we achieved the goal and successfully completed the toilet project.

Who will benefit from the project and how will the local community benefit?

510 children and schools teacher are benefited from implemented toilet project. And nearby community people are benefited from this project. They are using hygiene improvement 17 toilets. And our teachers, children and leader, local people are aware of disadvantage of no having proper/hygiene toilet. This project has developed their good health and reduced many common diseases. Community people are using this toilet when they gather in school boundary. Children, Teacher, Mission Leaders and BCSS Team are thankful to DCF Donor Agency for this great support.
